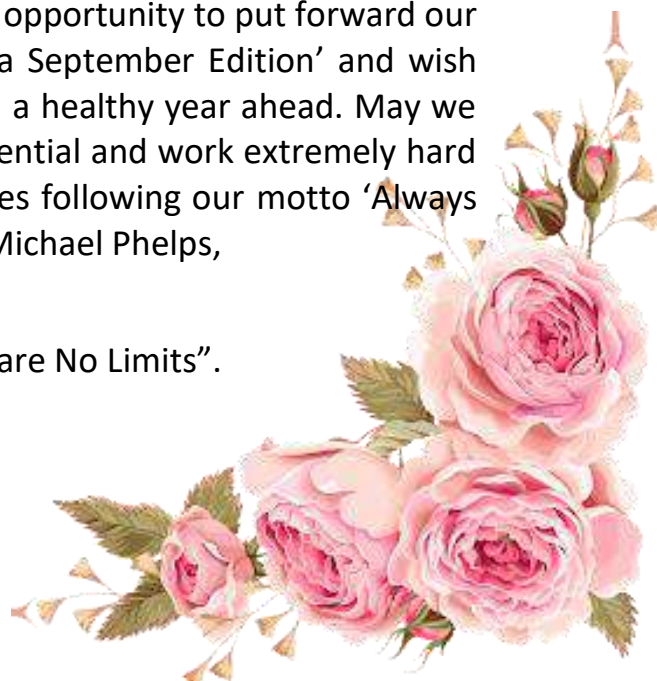

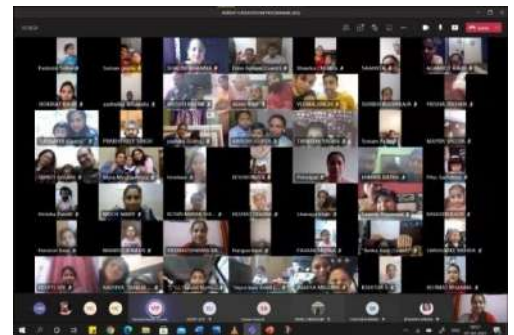
11 March 2021

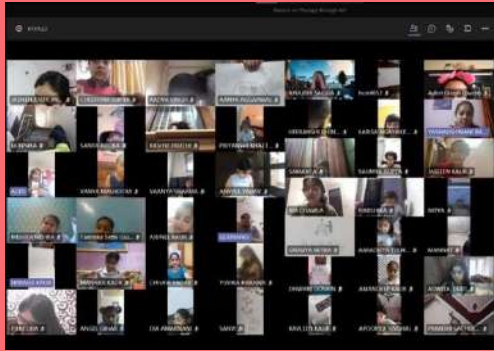
Virtual Meeting with International Universities

20/05/2021

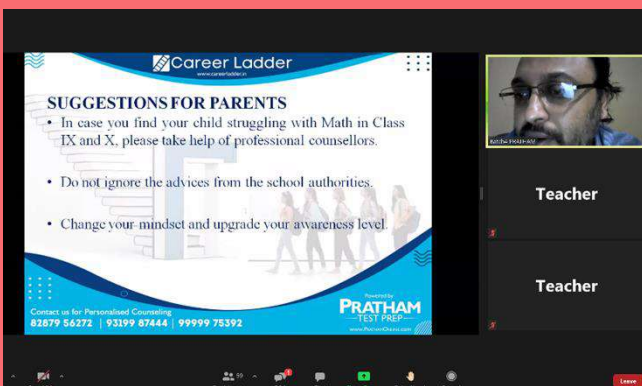

01/06/2021

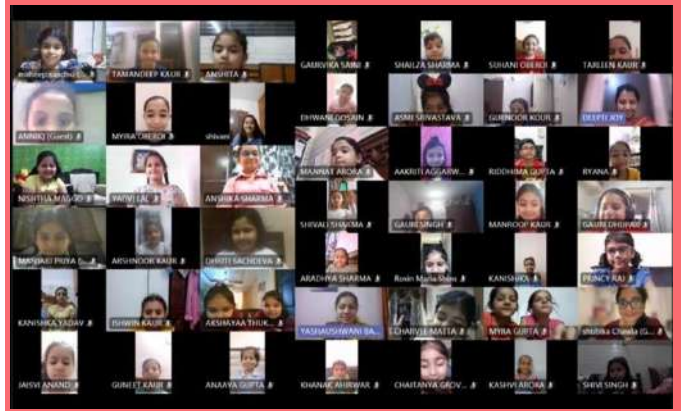

03/06/2021

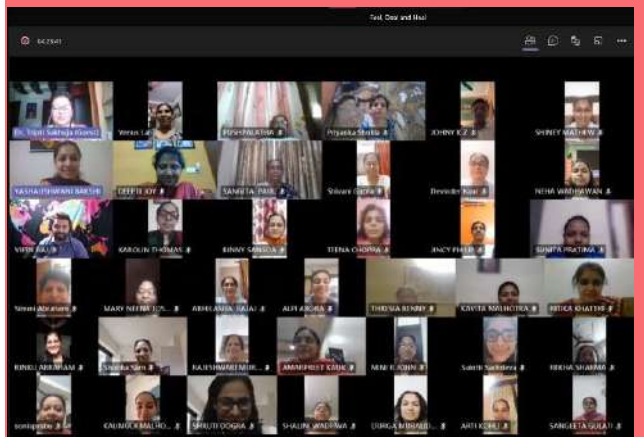

11 June, 2021

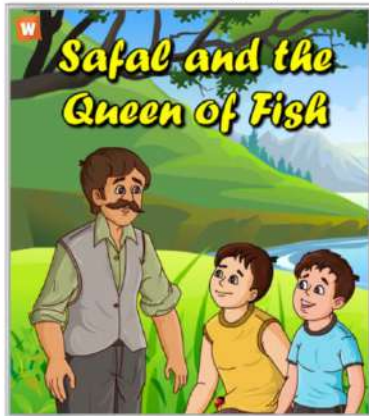

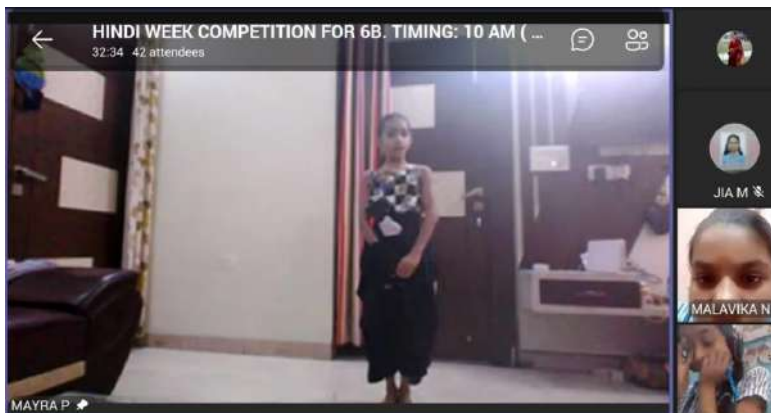
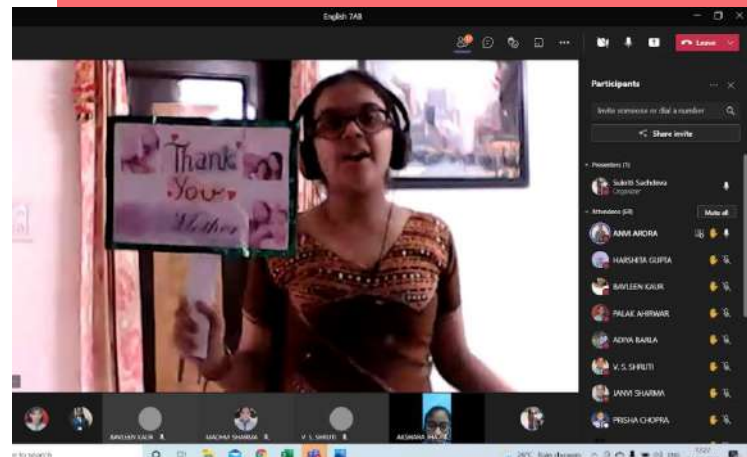
19 June, 2021

21-25 June 2021

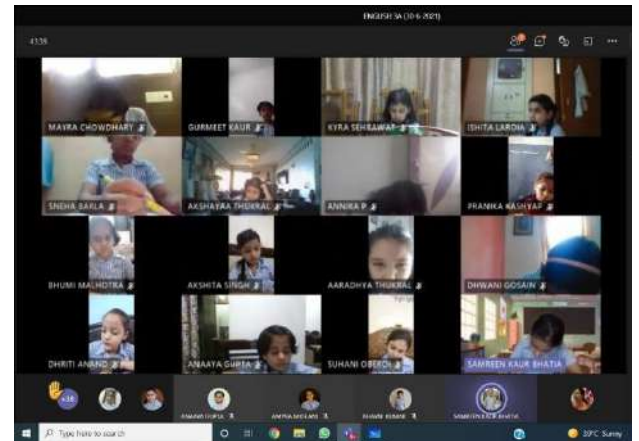

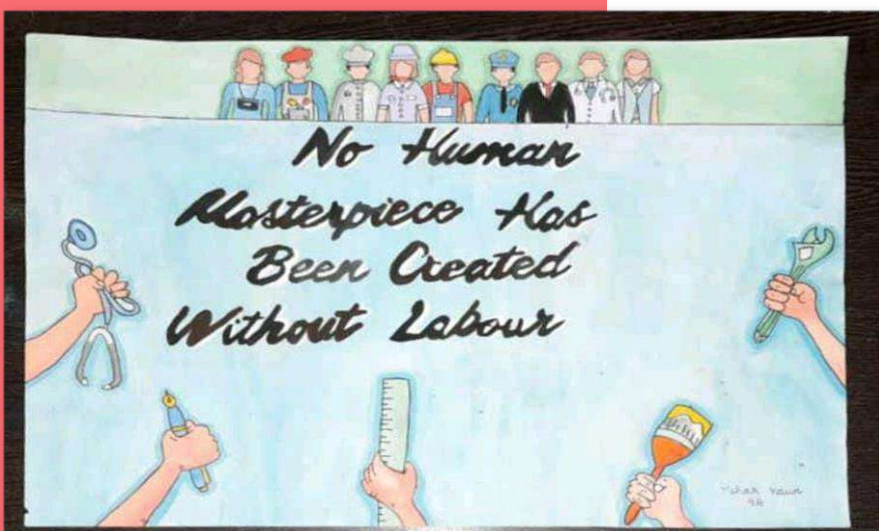
Labours' Day
