WORKSHOP ON IMPORTANCE OF APPROPRIATE LANGUAGE

A workshop on “To Say or Not to Say” i.e. Effects of Foul Language and Use of Appropriate Language was conducted for the students of class VII on May 4th, 2019 by the school counsellor. The workshop was conducted through presentation and a play was also performed by a group of students in order to make students relate to the consequences of foul language from a closer perspective. The session was interaction based and many students asked their doubts over usage of illicit language. The session was very interactive and was appreciated by everyone.
